WHITE WINE

Chardonnay - *One of the most widely planted grape varieties in the world, Chardonnay has many faces; it can be crisp and citrusy, or rich and toasty. The premium examples are creamy, complex and some of the most sought after wines in the world.*

Pinot Noir - *Delicate and elegant, red cherries and sometimes a touch of vanilla. If there's both fish and beef at the table, get a bottle of Pinot Noir.*

Merlot - *Quite an underestimated grape, Merlot is one of the Okanagan Valley's best expressions. These are very serious wines that offer aromatics like ripe plums, chocolate, vanilla, and tobacco.*

Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon - *Cabernet Sauvignon is known to be the bolder and more powerful version of its parent grape Cabernet Franc. One of the few exceptions for this rule is the Okanagan Valley, where Cab Franc is deeply coloured, peppery, and of superb structure.*

RED WINE

Shiraz and Syrah - *Same grape, two different styles, both have lots of personality. Some can be full of ripe fruit and black pepper, while the more delicate and elegant styles showcase aromas of dried violets and smoky meat. Both worth your consideration.*
